



But when I click on it, it gives me a warning "Your connection is not private. Attackers may be trying to steal your information"



When I select the second option from the initial search https://www.ufl.edu/alumni-and-friends/ then navigate to UF Alumni Association it takes me to the https://connect.ufalumni.ufl.edu/membership/join-the-ufaa page which seem to be legitimate.

I don't know if you think this is something that should be reported to UFAA for their IT to investigate.
