# RECEIVE TAX BENEFITS

## **EVEN IF YOU DON'T ITEMIZE**

When you transfer funds directly from your IRA to the University of Florida, you can earn tax savings and make an immediate impact on the programs at UF that mean the most to you.

A qualified charitable distribution (QCD), also called an IRA charitable rollover, is a direct transfer from your IRA to a qualified public charity.

In addition to making a meaningful impact at UF, an IRA charitable rollover may provide considerable tax advantages. Since the distribution is excluded from your taxable income, it allows you to receive tax benefits even if you do not itemize or are subject to charitable deduction limits. By lowering your adjusted gross income, you may also avoid being thrust into a higher income tax bracket.

# BENEFITS OF AN IRA CHARITABLE ROLLOVER GIFT



May count toward your annual required minimum distribution (RMD)\* up to the amount of your gift.



Giving assets rather than cash reduces the effect of your charitable giving on your cash flow.



The QCD is not included in your taxable income.



Simplifies the giving process. It's easy to do — just notify your IRA custodian.

\*The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 (Act) increased the age for required minimum distributions from retirement plans.

The Act increased the age retirees must begin taking taxable withdrawals to age 73 in 2023 and age 75 by 2033, up from age 72 under the previous law. IRA owners can still make a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) starting at age 70 ½. Additionally, beginning in 2024, the maximum annual QCD amount of \$100,000 will increase to account for inflation.
